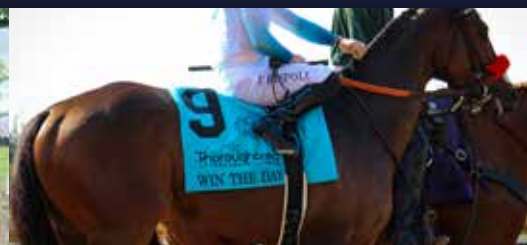

The non-profit 501(c)(3) Thoroughbred Aftercare Alliance accredits, inspects, and awards grants to approved aftercare organizations to retrain, retire and rehome Thoroughbreds using industry-wide funding.



WHAT MAKES US UNIQUE

ACCREDIT

We provide a professional and rigorous accreditation process for aftercare organizations.

AWARD

We provide financial assistance through grants earmarked for equine care.

INSPECT

We diligently and annually inspect our organizations and their approach to aftercare.



LIFE AFTER RACING

Thoroughbreds are versatile horses that can excel in any discipline. Thoroughbred Aftercare Alliance accredited organizations have transitioned former racehorses into five-star eventers, champions in the show ring, mounts for equine-assisted therapy programs, living tourism destinations, teachers of equine welfare in educational programs, and more.



Out of 86 Thoroughbred Aftercare Alliance accredited organizations:

- 69 offer adoption programs
- 59 offer sanctuary
- 71 offer rehabilitation
- 21 offer equine-assisted programs*

ACCREDITATION APPLICATION & SITE REVIEWS



The accreditation application is a comprehensive review of the organization, medical and husbandry procedures, and the organization's plans to prove sustainability of operations.

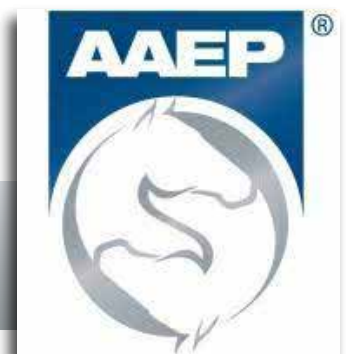
This review focuses on many areas including:

- Non-profit status
- Length of time an organization has been operating as an aftercare organization
- Financial stability
- History of caring for, retraining and placing of Thoroughbreds in adoptive homes
- Experience of managerial staff
- Insurance compliance
- Euthanasia and adoption policy and procedures

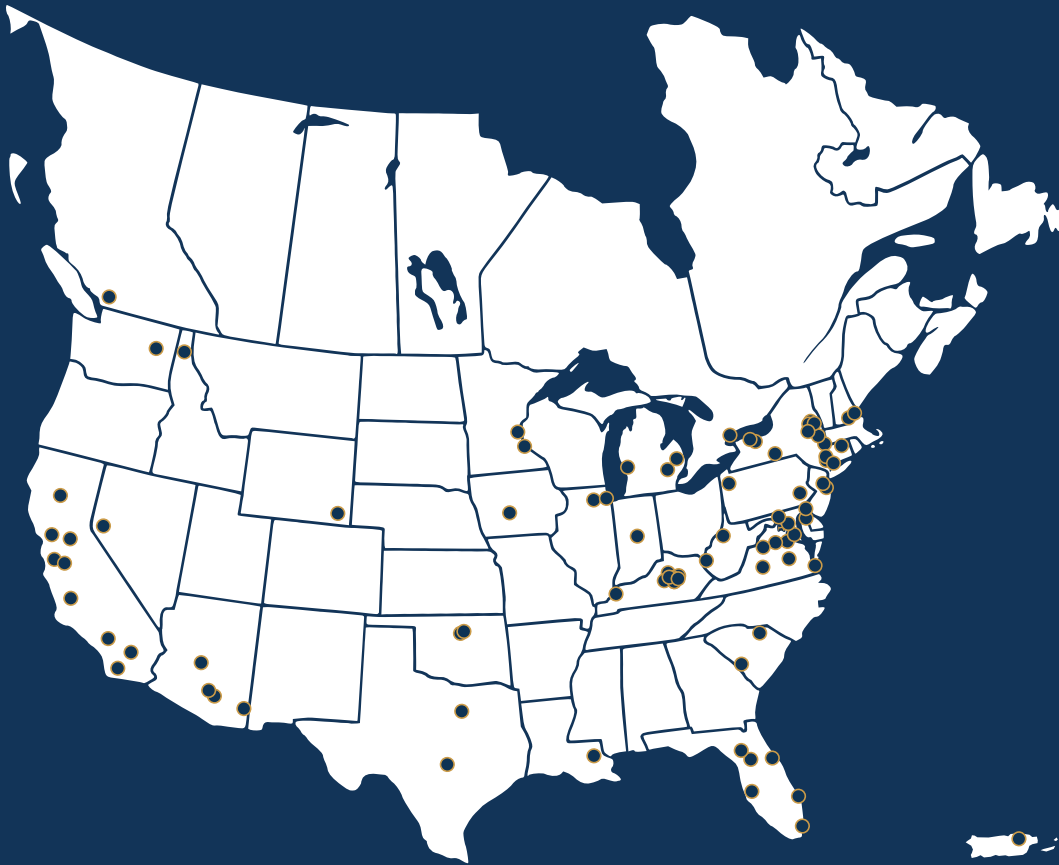
The accreditation site review is conducted by a veterinarian or Thoroughbred Aftercare Alliance representative and focuses on the following areas per the Thoroughbred Aftercare Alliance Code of Standards:

- Operations
- Education
- Horse health care management
- Facility standards and services
- Adoption policies and protocols

The Thoroughbred Aftercare Alliance's Code of Standards and accreditation process has been approved by the AAEP.

FUNDING

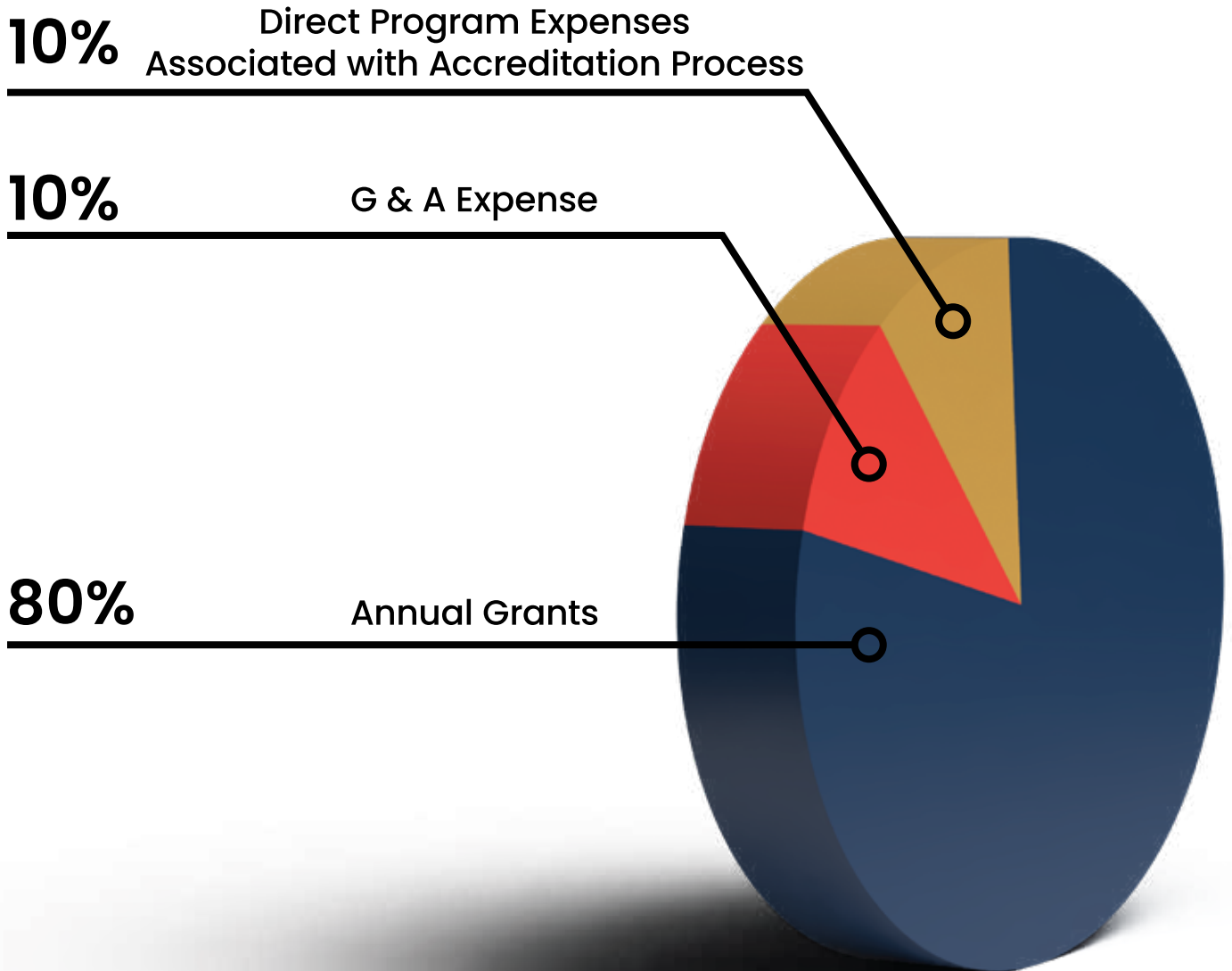
Since its inception and initial funding, Thoroughbred Aftercare Alliance has diligently sought to meet the challenging demands of aftercare for our athletes. We have broadened our donor base and developed numerous innovative efforts to increase the much-needed financial support of our industry stakeholders

Since 2012, Thoroughbred Aftercare Alliance has granted more than \$40.74 million to accredited organizations, which currently operate approximately 175 facilities across North America.

The demand greatly exceeds our ability to meet requests for support. We will continue to explore ways with our industry stakeholders to address the funding needs of aftercare.

COLLABORATIVE EFFORTS

Thoroughbred Aftercare Alliance collaborates with many aftercare efforts, including horsemen's groups, racetracks, and other equine breed associations in North America.

Thoroughbred Aftercare Alliance has created "The Thoroughbred Retirement Placement Program Best Practices" document for racetracks and horsemen's groups to use in their local communities.



In addition to the current accredited organizations, Thoroughbred Aftercare Alliance currently works with:

- CARMA in California, Beyond the Wire in Maryland, the Gulfstream Park Transition Program in Florida, and Take the Lead in New York
- Retired Racehorse Project, Thoroughbred Charities of America, International Forum for the Aftercare of Racehorses (IFAR), The Jockey Club Thoroughbred Incentive Program, as well as other state local horse shows and events
- Other breed associations and industry organizations including the United Horse Coalition, the United States Trotting Association, and the Standardbred Transition Alliance

INTERNATIONAL CONSULTATION

Thoroughbred Aftercare Alliance has consulted with and participated in many equine aftercare initiatives around the world since 2015.

- 2015 & 2016: Godolphin Aftercare Forum – Lexington, Kentucky & Newmarket, England
- 2018: IFAR Conference – South Korea; Presentation and Conference development.
- 2018–2019: The Standardbred Transition Alliance created after several years of consultation with the Thoroughbred Aftercare Alliance team and mentorship
- 2018 –2022: Thoroughbred Aftercare Alliance asked to consult with the Japan Racing Association, assisting with the creation of Japanese aftercare program. Coordinated tours of accredited facilities in North America.
- 2019 –2022: IFAR Conference – South Africa; Presentation and Conference development.
- 2021: In conjunction with Old Friends, consulted with Japanese horsemen to help establish the first retirement farm for Thoroughbred racehorses and create Old Friends Japan.
- 2022 –2024: Assisted in the coordination of returning some Thoroughbreds from South Korea to the United States as well as some rescues from kill pen situations. Working on potential consultation with South Korea for creation of an aftercare system.
- 2023: Contacted by representatives of Retraining of Racehorses, in England, for advice on starting their own accreditation program.
- 2024: Working with Tattersalls sales team in Ireland on developing a funding program for aftercare.
- 2024: Met with the Jamaican racing commission, veterinarians, and stewards to discuss aftercare programs in Jamaica
- 2024: Hong Kong
- 2024–2025: United Kingdom
- 2025: IFAR Conference – Lexington, Kentucky
- 2025: South Korea
