## ABOUT THOROUGHBRED AFTERCARE ALLIANCE

The 501(c)(3) nonprofit Thoroughbred Aftercare Alliance accredits, inspects, and awards grants to approved aftercare organizations to retrain, retire, and rehome Thoroughbreds using industry-wide funding.

Funded initially by seed money from Breeders' Cup Ltd., The Jockey Club, and Keeneland Association Inc., Thoroughbred Aftercare Alliance is supported by owners, trainers, breeders, racetracks, aftercare professionals, and other industry groups.

Since 2012, Thoroughbred Aftercare Alliance has granted more than \$4074 million to accredited aftercare organizations and 20,000+ Thoroughbreds have been retrained, rehomed, or retired by accredited organizations.

Currently, 86 organizations with approximately 175 facilities hold Thoroughbred Aftercare Alliance accreditation.
